Recession in 2020:

- 25% 78% chance
- Cautious Optimism
- Many feel the 2020 election will determine.

Travel Industry Impact:

With occupancy levels at record highs — even if a 2008 recession would happen the travel/hotel industry is in a much better position to handle it.

- 66% national occupancy average
- 9% drop would be 61%


